Growing Catnip

You can grow your own catnip plants in a home garden. The seeds can be harvested after the last major frost of the season.

More mature plants can be purchased from a nursery.

It is important to put the plant in an area where it has plenty of room to grow. Take steps to protect the growing plant from your cat so they don't tear it out of the soil before it is fully mature.

Catnip does not have the same effect on every cat, some do not seem interested in at all. The love of this plant is inherited, so only 50 to 70 percent of cats respond to catnip. Kittens typically ignore it until they are three to six months old.

Catnip is non-toxic but cat owners should use caution in giving it out too often. Some cats exhibit aggressive behavior when exposed to catnip and should not have it under any circumstances.



SENIOR PET WELLNESS CHECKS!

Bi-annual checks are recommended for cats and dogs greater than 8 years of age.

During these visits you and your pet will meet with Mike to :

- * *Assess your pet's health and discuss any changes that may have occurred since your last wellness check.*
- * *Complete thorough physical exam of your pet.*
- * *Vaccinate as appropriate.*
- * *Collect blood, and/or urine samples to determine your pet's health "on the inside". (Blood and urine measures enable to understand how well your pet's body is working. This informs our care and treatment plans. Based on these results dietary and/or medication changes may be recommended to improve your pet's current health and increase their lifespan.)*
- * *Ask your input and to encourage you to ask questions throughout the exam. Some people find it easier to write questions down before they come to the appointment.*
